1. Collection of information

The Company may collect the following types of personal data:

- Name and contact details (email, phone number)
- Information related to your requests and interactions with our lawyers
- Data about your visit to our website (IP address, browser type, device information, cookies)
- Information necessary to provide legal services

We collect data when you:

- Fill out forms on our website
- Contact us by email, phone or otherwise
- Use our services or interact with our lawyers

2. Use of data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

- Providing legal services
- Responding to your requests and questions
- Record keeping and customer relationship management
- Improving the quality of our website and services
- Complying with legal requirements and regulations

3. Sharing information with third parties

We do not sell, transfer or disclose your personal data to third parties, except in the following cases:

- When it is necessary to provide you with services (for example, interaction with external consultants or specialists)
- In the event of a legal request from government authorities or law enforcement agencies
- If it is necessary to protect the rights, property or safety of the Company, our customers or others

4. Data security

We take all reasonable organizational and technical measures to protect your personal data from unauthorized access, modification, disclosure or destruction. Access to data is limited to those employees and lawyers who need it to perform their duties.

5. Data storage

We store your data only for the time necessary to achieve the purposes of their processing, or for the periods stipulated by law. After this period, the data will be securely deleted or anonymized.

6. Your Rights
You have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data
- Correct or update your data
- Delete your data where required by law
- Restrict data processing or object to certain types of processing
- Receive a copy of your data in machine-readable format
